As advised last month, with the retirement from racing of both your fillies The Vicars Daughter and Drizella, Luby Lou is now the only filly that will be racing for your Syndicate.

Luby Lou is still in the spelling paddock recovering from her very unfortunate injury but is making good progress and it won't be long before she returns to training.

This is set to be in the first week of August and I'm sure Luby Lou will do you all proud and provide lots of fun and excitement next season.

Distribution

On the 25th June you were advised by email from Charanjit Ghuman from Gener8 Business & Life Solutions, that a distribution of funds was to be made to all syndicate members.

Just to reiterate, the advice was that as the syndicate now has only one horse left racing, Ken Breckon had confirmed a \$7,500 per share pay out would be made. This would leave a balance of funds of approximately \$35,000 for future costs with Luby Lou and so the distribution was to be paid to bank accounts on the 26th June 2018.

Hopefully this payment has arrived safely.

After the decision had been made to forego a Breeders Crown campaign, Luby Lou was to continue with her recovery programme, to ensure her injury had the best chance possible to heal completely.

On the 20th June Ken and Karen Breckon reported, "Someone is a happy girl with her new buddy. Eating well and sound. Hock still a bit swollen but her buddy that turned up last week has a hock twice as big which makes Luby's look minor. She is such a loving kind filly. We adore her. She is still at Karolyn's."

On the 14th July co-trainer Mark Purdon advised, "Luby Lou is still at Karolyn's. Her leg is coming along OK. She will start back in the first week of August and hopefully everything will be OK. It was certainly a tragedy that she was injured."

So, it won't be long now before Luby Lou returns to training and commences her build-up to what I'm sure will be a much-awaited return to racing.
